MAYOR'S REPORTS

Mayor Horwitz announced that Beachwood Place is open for business and is doing well. They had a good opening on Tuesday and are well equipped to handle any social distancing issues. Mall management is handing out masks when customers come in.

Mayor Horwitz announce on May 21, 2020, dine-in restaurants will open and on May 26, 2020 gyms and fitness centers will open and on May 31, 2020 child care will be open.

Mayor Horwitz also mentioned that the City will begin taking appointments for Barkwood and outlined the procedure for visiting the dog park. Mayor Horwitz stated that there is a list on the website which lists businesses that are open in the City of Beachwood.

Mayor Horwitz announced the closure of the Beachwood Family Aquatic Center for the 2020 summer season. The statement is attached hereto for the official record.

COUNCIL MEMBERS (NON-AGENDA ITEMS)

Mr. Burkons discussed concerns he had a with a previously approved Ordinance regarding Engineering Design Fees that were awarded to GPD Group.

Mayor Horwitz replied to Mr. Burkons concerns and stated that he would be open to a discussion in the future to possibly update the language in the Code Section that Mr. Burkons referred to.

Mr. Isaacson stated that he would like to review the process for awarding engineering fees and would like to review other communities and their process.

Mr. Synenberg wanted to remind everyone that during this time of Coronavirus separation, it is important to be aware of the mental health of your family and friends and encouraged everyone to reach out to someone you haven't talked to in a while and check in.

DEPARTMENT DIRECTOR REPORTS

Ms. Calta spoke about the issue Mr. Burkons raised during Council Members remarks. Ms. Calta stated that she would like to have a Public Works Committee Meeting to discuss an update to BCO Chapter 169.

Ms. Carmen spoke about the work of the Community Services Department. They have distributed 1,245 masks to 621 Seniors and made approximately 3000 wellness calls in 45 days to Seniors in City of Beachwood.

Ms. Carmen stated that the Memorial Day flag will be painted on the lawn on the Richmond Road side of City Hall and said that this year the flag will be painted in different colors that represent First Responders.

Ms. Carmen stated that Barkwood has been reopened and 102 slots have been filled for appointments to visit the dog park. Ms. Carmen also stated that Flags for First Responder are up to 75 flags donated.

Mr. Arrietta stated that today was the first day of mulch distribution and said that approximately 2500 hundred bags were picked up just today.

Mr. Synenberg requested that Mr. Arrietta provide the schedule and information on how to pick up the mulch.

Mr. Arrietta replied that mulch pick-up is Monday through Friday 7:30 AM to 3:30 PM. Proof of residency is required.

Mr. Griswold introduced Dale Steppenbacker. Mr. Steppenbacker will be appointed as a new Building Inspector/Special Police Officer during tonight's meeting.

AN ORDINANCE TO OBTAIN FUNDING FROM THE STATE OF OHIO PURSUANT TO SB 310; AND DECLARING THIS TO BE AN URGENT MEASURE

WHEREAS, the state legislature, pursuant to SB 310, created a mechanism to distribute nearly 1.2 billion of federal financial aid to Ohio's local governments having populations with fewer than 500,00 residents, as provided by the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security ("CARES") Act; and

WHEREAS, more specifically, the state legislature had designated \$350 million of the 1.2 billion of the federal financial aid for disbursement through the Local Government Fund to be used only for non-budgeted COVID-19 related expenses, per the guidelines provided by the U.S. Department of Treasury; and

WHEREAS, funding being distributed will be distributed based on the proportion of the Local Government Fund revenue allocated to the City in 2019 and is estimated to be approximately \$140,000; and

WHEREAS, SB 310 requires that for the City to obtain its funding, legislation must be passed by its legislative authority stating that the City will follow the guidelines established by the U.S. Department of Treasury on how the federal aid may be spent and acknowledging that use of such funding may only be for necessary expenditures incurred due to the public health emergency with the COVID-19 pandemic, provided the expenses are incurred between March 1 and December 30, 2020, and are not accounted for in the City's current budget; and

WHEREAS, in addition, the legislation must be submitted to the Cuyahoga County Auditor and the Ohio Office of Budget and Management.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Beachwood, County of Cuyahoga and State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: City Council hereby affirms that any funding it may receive through the Local Government Fund as allocated per SB 310 shall only be expended to cover the costs of the City that are consistent with the requirements of the CARES Act. Any unused funds that remain unencumbered as of October 15, 2020 are required to be returned to the County treasury and any unspent funds must be returned to the State treasury by December 28, 2020.

Section 2: City Council authorizes the Mayor and Finance Director to sign any documents or take any actions in furtherance of obtaining the funding being allocated to the City per SB 310, including but not limited to establishing a dedicated fund to be called the, "Local Coronavirus Relief Fund."

Section 3: City Council directs its Clerk of Council forthwith to forward a certified copy of the legislation to the County Auditor's Office and to the Director of the Ohio Office of Budget and Management.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING BEACHWOOD CODIFIED ORDINANCE SECTION 105.01 WHEREBY COUNCIL DETERMINES THAT THE OFFICIAL MINUTES OF ITS BODY, ITS COMMITTEES, AND THOSE OF THE PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION SHALL CONSIST OF THE VIDEO RECORDING OF THE MEETINGS; AND DECLARING THIS TO BE AN URGENT MEASURE

WHEREAS, City Council, pursuant to Ordinance 2017-107, determined that the official minutes of its body, its committees, and those of the Planning and Zoning Commission shall consist of the audio recording of the meeting together with a written synopsis of all agenda items and votes; and

WHEREAS, City Council now wishes to determine that the official minutes of its body, its committees, and those of the Planning and Zoning Commission shall consist of the video recording of the meeting.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Beachwood, Cuyahoga County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: Council hereby amends BCO Chapter 105 titled "Public Meetings," by amending Section 105.01 to read as follows:

105.01 MEETINGS OF COUNCIL, BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS; MINUTES.

(a) Council, the Planning and Zoning Commission, the Architectural Board of Review, the Recreation Board, the Civil Service Commission and all other boards and commissions of the City and any committee thereof are hereby declared to be public bodies and their meetings shall be open to the public except hereinafter set forth. As used in this chapter "meeting" means any prearranged discussion of the public business of the public body by a majority of its members. The minutes of a regular or special meeting of any public body shall be promptly recorded and be open to the public for inspection at reasonable times. Such minutes need only reflect the general subject matter of discussion in executive session.

(b) Council determines that the Official Meeting Minutes of its body, its Committees and those of the Planning and Zoning Commission shall consist of the video recording of the meetings. A written synopsis which details the general discussion on each agenda item, as well as the votes on all ordinances, resolutions and motions shall also be promptly prepared and kept. In the event that the video system is not functioning during any meeting, the Clerk of Council or Secretary of the Planning and Zoning Commission shall prepare detailed written minutes of the meeting and any future meetings until the video is restored.

Section 2: This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council and any of its committees concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council or committees, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its communities that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, all in compliance with the law.

Section 3: This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety or the efficient operation of the City; and for the further reason that this Ordinance is required to be immediately effective to provide for the formal minutes of Council and Committee meetings; wherefore this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest date permitted by law.

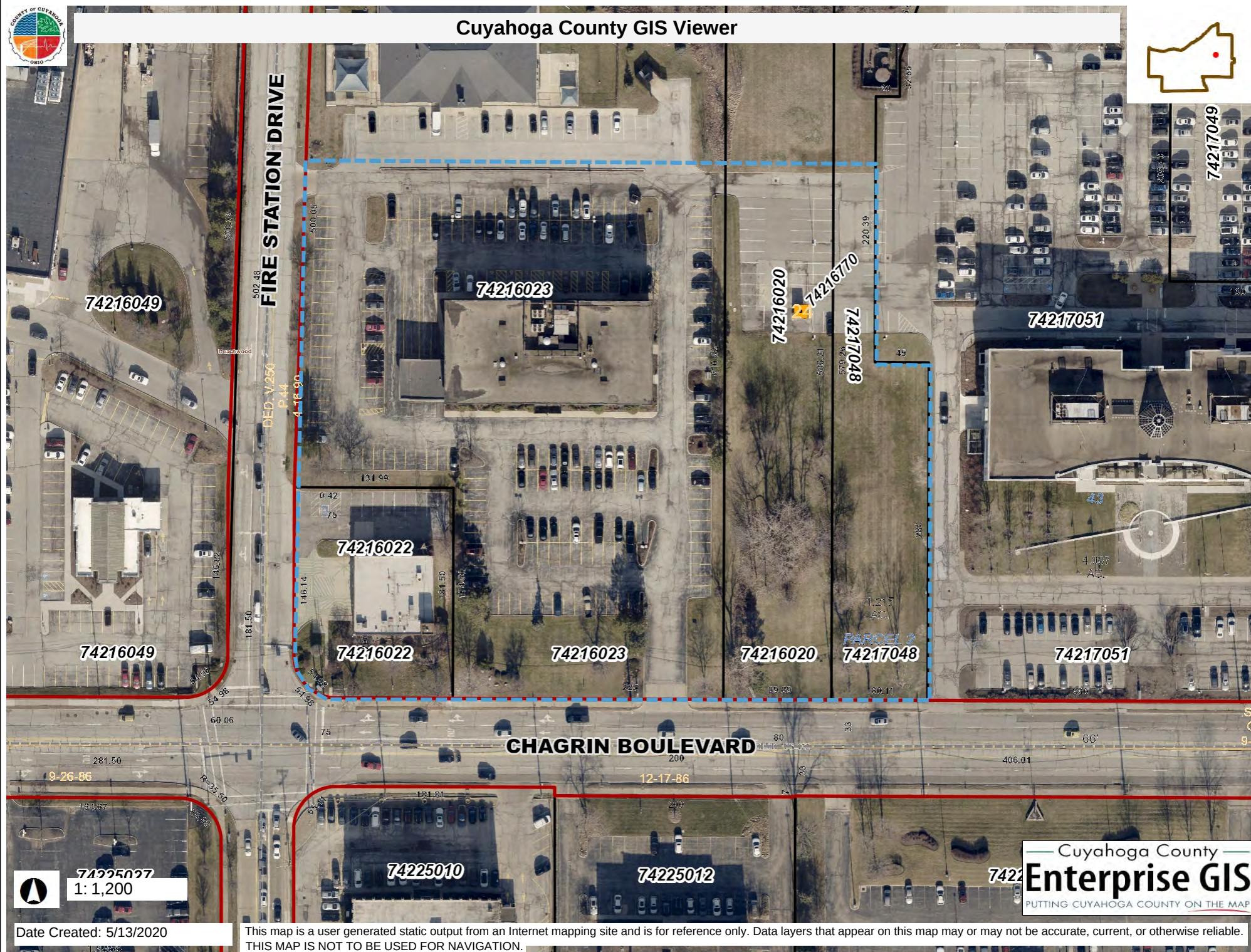

This request is for rezoning approximately 5.16 acres of land located on the northeast corner of the intersection of Chagrin Boulevard and Fire Station Drive from U-5 Public and Institutional District and U-7A General Office Building District to U-4A Integrated Business District. The subject site has approximately 500 feet of frontage on Chagrin Boulevard and 400 feet of frontage on Fire Station Drive. The property to be rezoned includes old Fire Station No. 2, an adjacent office building, and vacant land with frontage on Chagrin Boulevard. This rezoning is the first step in repurposing the old fire station. The old fire station site is zoned U-5 Public and Institutional District, while the surrounding parcels included in the rezoning are zoned U-7A General Office Building District. The intent of including the additional parcels is to enhance the development potential of the old fire station site, which has little ability to accommodate parking because of its size.

The subject site would be surrounded on the north and east by properties zoned U-7A General Office Building District. To the south, across Chagrin Boulevard the properties are zoned U-7A General Office Building District. To the west, across Fire Station Drive, is the Pavilion Shopping Center, which is zoned U-4A Integrated Business District. The new commercial zoning district would not abut any residentially zoned properties.

The applicants are considering creating a food truck park on the old fire station portion of the site, however the only issue before the Commission at this time is the rezoning. Should the rezoning be approved, they would need to return to the Planning and Zoning Commission for site development plan approvals for the intended uses.

This rezoning provides the opportunity to reuse the old fire station building in an effective manner that puts it back onto the tax rolls and would complement the adjacent Pavilion Shopping Center by expanding retail and restaurant options serving the Commerce Park area and the new housing along Chagrin Boulevard. The proposed rezoning is consistent with the concepts and strategies set forth in the City's Comprehensive Plan.

This Master Agreement (the “Agreement”) made and entered into this _____, 2020 (the Effective Date”) and between County of Cuyahoga, Ohio, a body corporate and politic and a political subdivision of the State of Ohio organized and existing under the Charter of Cuyahoga County effective January 1, 2010, as same may have been amended, modified, and supplemented to the date hereof, on behalf of the Department of Public Works (the “County”) and the following State Ohio municipalities (hereinafter referenced individually as “Municipality” and collectively as “Municipalities”) identified as follows:

RECITALS:

A. Pursuant to Section 806.02 of Cuyahoga County Code, the County selected the Municipalities to participate in the Cuyahoga Countywide Preventive Maintenance Program; and

B. Pursuant to an award letter dated February 24, 2020 and May 7, 2020, the Municipalities will be reimbursed by the County for performing the following preventive maintenance activities on County roadways located in such Municipalities: pavement resurfacing, base repairs, curb replacement/repairs, curb ramp repairs, rebuilding of utility catch basins/manholes, pavement striping, crack sealing, pavement joint repair, and other similar maintenance activities approved by the County (the “Preventive Maintenance”); and

C. The County recognizes the need to protect its financial investment in the County’s roadway infrastructure and desires to reimburse the Municipalities for Preventive Maintenance services according to the terms and conditions herein; and

D. The Municipalities have recognized that such Preventive Maintenance services are in the public interest and desire to cooperate with the County in the provision of such services.

In consideration of the mutual agreements, promises, representations and warranties made herein and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the parties agree as follows:

1. The foregoing recitals are incorporated herein as if fully rewritten herein.
2. The County will reimburse each Municipality for actual costs of materials used by the Municipalities in performing Preventive Maintenance on County roadways in an amount not to exceed the amount described in Exhibit A, attached to this Agreement and incorporated as fully rewritten herein. Unless otherwise approved by the County, County will not reimburse Municipalities for the cost of labor used in performing such Preventive Maintenance.
3. The County has indicated the approved Preventive Maintenance for each Municipality in the award letters dated February 24, 2020 and May 7, 2020, attached to this Agreement as Exhibit B and incorporated as fully rewritten herein. The County, through the Director of Public Works, reserves the right to make modifications to the projects listed in Exhibit B, provided that such modifications do not exceed to total reimbursable amount awarded for each Municipality.
4. The Municipalities shall perform the Preventive Maintenance during the 2020 construction year but no later than December 31, 2020. The obligation of the County to pay eligible costs for Preventive Maintenance pursuant to the terms and conditions of this Agreement shall expire on September 30, 2021. Upon the expiration of the aforesaid date, the County shall not be obligated to reimburse the Municipalities for any Preventive Maintenance services.
5. In the event a Municipality breaches any term of this Agreement, the County reserves the right to supply written notice of an intent to terminate the Agreement. The Municipality shall have thirty (30) calendar days to cure the breach from the date of its receipt of the notice of breach. If the Municipality fails to cure the breach within thirty (30) calendar days the Agreement shall immediately and automatically terminate for cause. The County shall pay the Municipality for the actual costs incurred by the Municipality for performing eligible Preventive Maintenance services prior to the date of termination.
6. Upon completion of the Preventive Maintenance, the Municipalities will continue to maintain all the County roadways in accordance with the statutes relating thereto and agree to follow and maintain post-construction Best Management Practices as outlined in the Municipal Storm Water Permit that is filed with the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency. The County will not be responsible for further maintenance of the roadway improvements.
7. This Agreement may be executed in multiple counterparts, each of which, when so executed, shall be deemed an original, and all of which shall together constitute one and the same document, and shall be binding on the signatories; and the signature of any party to any

counterpart shall be deemed a signature to, and may be appended to, any other counterpart. This Agreement may be executed and delivered by facsimile or electronically in Microsoft Word or PDF format.

8. By entering into this Agreement, each Municipality agrees on to conduct this transaction by electronic means by agreeing that all documents requiring County signatures may be executed by electronic means, and that the electronic signatures affixed by the County to said documents shall have the same legal effect as if that signature was manually affixed to a paper version of the document. Municipality also agree on behalf of the aforementioned entities and persons to be bound by the provisions of Chapters 304 and 1306 of the Ohio Revised Code as they pertain to electronic transactions, and to comply with the electronic signature policy of the COUNTY

Mayor,

Per our discussion on Tuesday, May 26, I would like to place the resurfacing of Annesley, Edgewood, Brentwood and the Asphalt Patch Program on the Agenda for the June 1st Council meeting. Ronyak was the lowest and best bidder for our 2020 Road Program and will perform the work. Ronyak has worked in the City in the past and has performed well on all of their projects. Per Joe Ciuni's recommendation letter, the total cost for the 2020 Road and Patch Program will be \$974,081.60.

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING A CERTAIN BID FROM RONYAK PAVING, INC., FOR THE 2020 ROAD IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM; AND DECLARING THIS TO BE AN URGENT MEASURE

WHEREAS, three (3) bids were received by the Clerk on March 13, 2020, for the 2020 Road Improvement Program, pursuant to an advertisement for competitive bidding as required by law; and

WHEREAS, the bid of Ronyak Paving, Inc. in an amount not to exceed One Million, Six Hundred Sixty-Seven Thousand, Eight Hundred Thirty-Two Dollars and Twenty-Eight Cents (\$1,667,832.28) and an Add Alternate for the widening of Selkirk Road in an amount not to exceed Forty-Five Thousand, Four Hundred Fifty-Nine Dollars and No/Cents (\$45,459.00), was the lowest and best bid received; and

WHEREAS, due to current COVID-19 uncertainties, Ronyak Paving, Inc. and the City of Beachwood have agreed to non-perform a portion of the specified project, including the exclusion of the Add Alternate for the widening of Selkirk Road; and

WHEREAS, the Road Improvement Program will now only include the repaving of Annesley Road, Brentwood Road, Edgewood Road, and Asphalt Patching on Fairmount Boulevard and Green Road in a total amount not to exceed Nine Hundred Seventy-Four Thousand, Eighty-One Dollars and Sixty Cents (\$974,081.60); and

WHEREAS, the City of Beachwood will be reimbursed Seventy-Six Thousand Dollars (\$76,000.00) by the Cuyahoga County Engineer's Office for the Asphalt Patching; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Director and City Engineer recommend that Council accept the bid of Ronyak Paving, Inc. for the 2020 Road Improvement Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Beachwood, County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: Based upon the recommendation of the Public Works Director and the City Engineer, the bid of Ronyak Paving, Inc., is found to be the lowest and best bid received for the 2020 Road Improvement Program,, which excludes certain non-performed items and includes those roads identified by the City Engineer in his letter to Public Works Director Chris Arrietta, dated May 27, 2020, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit "A", in an amount not to exceed Nine Hundred Seventy-Four Thousand, Eighty-One Dollars and Sixty Cents (\$974,081.60).

Section 2: The Mayor is authorized to enter into a contract on behalf of the City of Beachwood, Ohio with said Company.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions and deliberations of Council and its committees, relating to the passage of this legislation that resulted in formal action were in meetings open to the public where required by Chapter 105 of the Codified Ordinances of the City.

The add alternate is to widen Selkirk Road by 3 feet on either side to provide a wide berm for pedestrians.

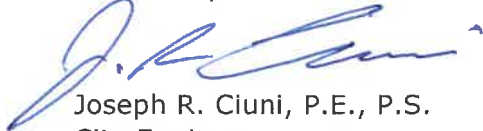

CONTRACT WITH RONYAK PAVING, INC. FOR THE 2020 ROAD IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM

This Contract entered into by and between RONYAK PAVING, INC., 11938 MAYFIELD ROAD, BLDG. A, CHARDON, OHIO 44024 ("Contractor") and the CITY OF BEACHWOOD, 25325 FAIRMOUNT BOULEVARD, BEACHWOOD, OHIO 44122 ("City");

WHEREAS, the Clerk of Council, pursuant to a Motion passed by Council on **February 20, 2020**, advertised for bids for the work and/or services, hereinafter described, on **February 27, 2020 and on March 5, 2020** which bids were due on or before **1:00 o'clock P.M. on Friday, March 13, 2020**, at which time all bids were publicly opened and immediately tabulated and filed for public inspection with the Clerk of Council; and

WHEREAS, Council received the tabulation of the bids at a Public meeting held on **June 1, 2020**, at which time Council adopted **Ordinance No. 2020-** approving the bid of the Contractor to be the lowest and best bid ("Bid") and awarding this Contract.

WITNESSETH, that in consideration of the Contractor being recommended by the Public Works Director and chosen by the City, and for the money considerations provided herein, the parties covenant and agree as follows:

1. Based upon the recommendation of the Public Works Director, and as approved by City Council, the Mayor is authorized to enter into this Contract for the 2020 Road Improvement Program with the Contractor, in an amount not to exceed Nine Hundred Seventy-Four Thousand, Eighty-One Dollars and Sixty Cents (\$974,081.60).

2. The Contractor shall provide labor and materials for the 2020 Road Improvement Program as submitted in its bid proposal and in accordance with the City's specifications. Before commencing any work, Contractor shall submit an action plan for approval by the Beachwood Police Department showing the means the Contractor will use to comply with the Supervision and Safety requirements contained in the specifications. All work shall be completed in accordance with a time schedule approved by the Public Works Director.

3. The Contractor shall furnish the Public Works Director and City Finance Director with a record of services rendered monthly, not later than five (5) days following the end of each month of the activity on forms approved by the Finance Director.

4. The Contractor is an independent contractor, having discretion over the means, methods and details of the services to be performed consistent with the overall goals and policies of the Public Works Department of the City of Beachwood, and shall provide all equipment, materials and labor necessary to perform the services. Contractor shall provide any necessary training of its employees. Contractor shall be responsible for arranging for Workers' Compensation coverage or equivalent for its employees, and shall deliver to the City a copy of a certificate showing compliance with such laws and shall comply with all laws applicable in the City of Beachwood or the State of Ohio. Contractor shall be responsible for verifying that the most current wage rates are utilized and for any changes in the prevailing wage rates or classifications throughout its performance of this Contract.

5. The City shall be entitled to cancel this Contract upon giving a five (5) days written notice to the Contractor for failure of the Contractor to comply with any of the provisions of this Contract or to furnish satisfactory work in connection with the required services.

The City shall be entitled to terminate this Contract immediately upon a determination by the Public Works Director or Safety Director of the City that any act or omission arising from the work jeopardizes the safety or health of any person. The Contractor shall perform all work in accordance with all Federal, State and local laws and regulations governing such services. The Contractor shall operate during times approved and specified by the City.

6. Contractor shall provide labor and materials for the 2020 Road Improvement Program without any sub-contractors and will provide proper supervision and supervisory personnel in connection therewith.

7. Contractor shall furnish the City with evidence of general liability insurance from a company licensed by the State of Ohio in the amount of One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) for any accidental occurrence arising out of any act or omission by the Contractor which causes bodily harm or property damage, and shall cause the City to be named as an additional insured on the policy. Contractor agrees to fully defend, indemnify and hold the City harmless from any and all claims, demands or causes of action for personal injury, property damage or otherwise arising from the services provided under this Contract, and whether involving employee claims or third party claims.

8. Ohio law prohibits any state agency or political subdivision from awarding a Contract, in excess of twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000.00), for goods, services, or construction to any person against whom a finding of recovery has been issued by the Auditor of State, if that finding is unresolved. Contractor certifies that an unresolved finding for recovery has not been issued against Contractor and attached is a completed Findings For Recovery Certification.

9. This Contract consists of this instrument and the component parts attached hereto, all of which are incorporated herein as if fully rewritten, numbered and signed by the parties. Such documents, unless waived in writing by the Law Director, shall include, but are not limited to, plans and drawings, specifications, warranties, performance bond approved by the City Law Director, proof of satisfactory liability insurance, proof of workers' compensation coverage in accordance with the laws of Ohio, the laws of the City of Beachwood, copies of advertisement, bid tabulations and purchase orders.

10. It shall be the responsibility of Ronyak Paving, Inc. to obtain a copy of the purchase order issued by the City for the approved amount of this Contract. Furthermore, it shall be the responsibility of Ronyak Paving, Inc. to track remaining funds available and to not invoice the City for any amounts not approved by the terms of this Contract. Any alterations to this Contract shall conform to BCO 121.09(a). Invoices that exceed the approved amount of this Contract will not be paid by the City.

11. In the event of dispute, the Contractor first shall be required to and shall have the right to appeal directly to the Council of the City of Beachwood, and a decision by Council shall be a condition precedent to the institution of any litigation in a court of competent jurisdiction. Any legal action arising out of this Contract shall be brought only in a court of competent jurisdiction sitting in Cuyahoga County, Ohio.

12. This Contract may be executed by electronic mail, facsimile and in counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original and all of which shall be deemed to be one and the same instrument.

13. Contractor acknowledges that no modifications can be made to this Contract without prior written action and prior approval by the Mayor and City Council.

14. This Contract represents the entire agreement between the parties, will be governed by the laws of the State of Ohio, and shall be binding upon both parties. This Contract cannot be assigned by the Contractor without the prior written permission of the City.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING BCO CHAPTER 1124, SECTION 1124.10, TITLED
“REZONING” OF THE CITY OF BEACHWOOD, OHIO PLANNING AND ZONING CODE

WHEREAS, Mayor Horwitz requested an amendment to BCO Chapter 1124, Section 1124.10, titled “Rezoning”; and

WHEREAS, it is Council’s desire to refer said requested amendment to its Planning and Zoning Commission for study and a report and recommendation in accordance with BCO 1107.01.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Beachwood, County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Council of the City of Beachwood, having received, on or about February 20, 2020, a request from Mayor Horwitz for an amendment to the City’s Planning and Zoning Code, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit “A”, placed said amendment on first reading, and referred the proposed amendment to the Planning and Zoning Commission for its report and recommendation on March 2, 2020.

The proposed amendment was recommended for approval by the Planning and Zoning Commission at its April 27, 2020 meeting.

Upon Council’s receipt of the recommendation of the Planning and Zoning Commission the issue of amending the current BCO Section 1124.10 shall be set for Public Hearing.

The Public Hearing shall be held on the 6th day of July, 2020 at 7:15 P.M. at the Beachwood City Hall, Council Chambers, 25325 Fairmount Boulevard, Beachwood, Ohio.

This Ordinance shall be read by Council on three separate occasions and its passage shall cause the Proposed Amendment to become effective upon operation of the law.

Section 2: The Clerk of Council is directed to advertise said hearing in a newspaper of general circulation in the City for a period of not less than thirty (30) days prior to the Public Hearing, setting forth the substance of the amendments which are proposed.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions and deliberations of Council and its committees relating to the passage of this legislation that resulted in formal action were in meetings open to the public where required by Chapter 105 of the Codified Ordinances of the City.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest date permitted by law.

EXHIBIT A

1124.10 REZONING.

In order to protect established single family residential neighborhoods, to preserve the single family residential character of the City, and to otherwise carry out the purposes of this Code, no land shall be rezoned from a Class U-1 Single-Family House District to a Class U-5 Public and Institutional District where such rezoning involves the consolidation of existing single family lots and/or the demolition, destruction, or removal of existing single family residences **except to address dangers to public health and/or safety as documented in reports by the Police Chief and Fire Chief and as determined by City Council.**
