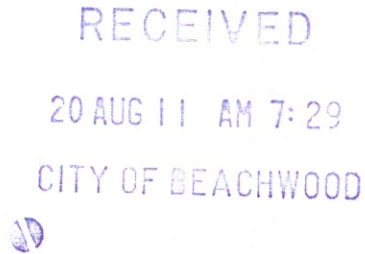

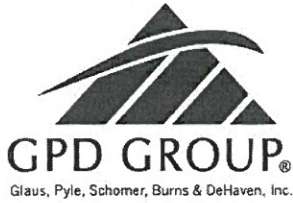

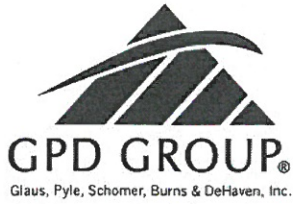

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ACCEPT A PROPOSAL FROM GLAUS, PYLE, SCHOMER, BURNS AND DEHAVEN, INC. DBA GPD GROUP TO PROVIDE A PHASE 2 DRAINAGE STUDY FOR THE BRYDEN-GREEN AREA IN THE CITY OF BEACHWOOD, OHIO; AND DECLARING THIS TO BE AN URGENT MEASURE

WHEREAS, the Mayor previously authorized the Bryden-Green Drainage Study- Phase 1 in the City of Beachwood, Ohio on or about May 15, 2020; and

WHEREAS, based upon the observations and findings in the Phase 1 Study and as discussed with the City's Public Works Committee on August 31st, 2020, GPD Group has submitted a Proposal to provide a Phase 2- Bryden-Green Drainage Study; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Director has recommended accepting the Proposal from GPD Group to provide the Phase 2 Study in an amount not to exceed Twenty-Four Thousand Two Hundred and Ten Dollars and No/ Cents (\$24,210.00).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Beachwood, County of Cuyahoga and State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: Based upon the recommendation of the Public Works Director, the Mayor is hereby authorized to accept the Proposal from Glaus, Pyle, Schomer, Burns and Dehaven, Inc. dba GPD Group ("GPD Group") for the Bryden-Green Drainage Study-Phase 2 in the City of Beachwood, Ohio in an amount not to exceed Twenty-Four Thousand Two Hundred and Ten Dollars and No/ Cents (\$24,210.00), a copy of the Proposal is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit "A".

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions and deliberations of Council and its committees relating to the passage of this legislation that resulted in formal action were in meetings open to the public where required by Chapter 105 of the Codified Ordinances of the City.

Section 3: This Ordinance is declared to be an urgent measure which is immediately necessary for the public peace, health, safety or the efficient operation of the City, and for the further reason that the project may begin as soon as possible; wherefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest date permitted by law.

Re: Bryden-Green Drainage study – Phase 2

To continue our study for the Bryden-Green intersection drainage improvements we will need to field survey the upstream and downstream channel and we need to field verify the pipe sizes and inverts that tie into the 8' X 3' box culvert. All topographic features located in and around the channels will be located and mapped. We will also establish property lines to determine the impact on each property owner.

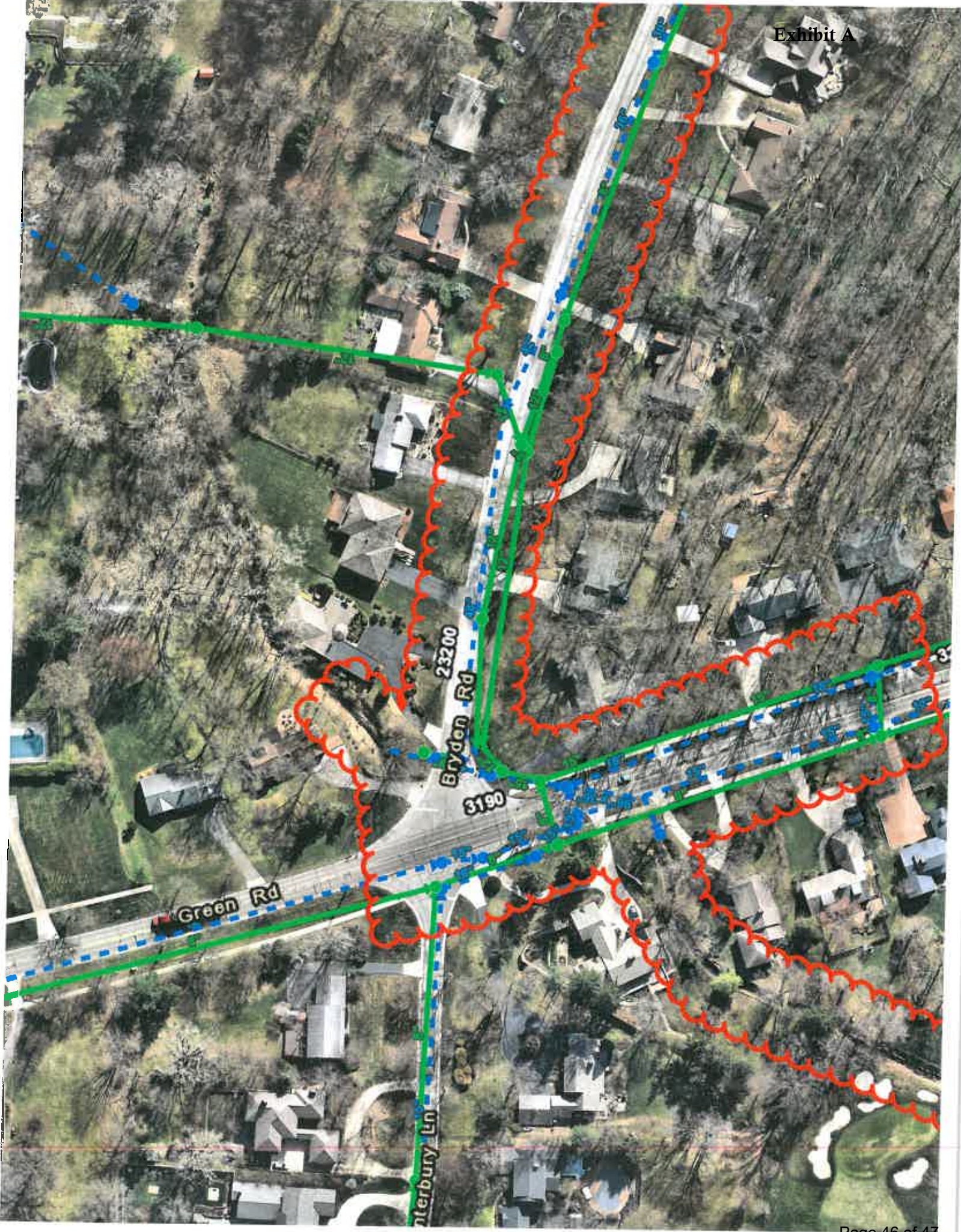
After the field survey is obtained and mapped, GPD will analyze the data and develop options for increasing the size of the channel to handle the addition of a second 8' X 3' box culvert. The GPD hydraulic and civil engineering staff will prepare conceptual drawings to present to the homeowners and to Canterbury Golf Club.

Finally, we will develop cost estimates for the recommended options.

Enclosed is our Survey cost estimate (\$13,710) and an aerial photo of the limits of work.

Our fee for the Engineering services mentioned above is \$10,500.

Therefore the requested fee for this phase of the work is \$24,210.
