3. EUCLID CREEK WATERSHED PROGRAM

Kate Chapel (Euclid Creek Watershed Coordinator, Cuyahoga Soil and Water Conservation District Educator) discussed the Public Involvement and Public Education (PIPE) programs available to Beachwood. She also plans to have a Master Rain Gardner program in Beachwood in 2024.

Chris Vasco (Cuyahoga Soil and Water Conservation District Stormwater Specialist) discussed monthly Active Construction inspections as well as yearly Post Construction inspections. He also discussed Good Housekeeping required on City properties.

Note: Agenda items 3. And 5. were combined into item 3. Therefore items 6. and 7. changed to items 5. and 6. Item 4 was unchanged.

4. UPDATE ON STORM SEWER MASTER PLAN

Dave DiCesare (G.P.D. Water Project Manager) explained typical sanitary sewer systems within the City of Beachwood. He also discussed completed sewer upgrades and future projects. The completed projects are already providing significant reduction in flooding for Beachwood residents.

5. ANY OTHER MATTERS COMING BEFORE THE STORMWATER COMMISSION

Chris Arrietta thanked the G.P.D. staff and Chris Vild for working on the Master Plan and thus eliminating basement flooding for many Beachwood residents.

Chris Vild described how Beachwood is the headwaters of six watersheds and what occurs in Beachwood has regional effects. He also mentioned how the County Public Works Department and capital improvements to Beachwood infrastructure benefit the region.

Alwyn Chao thanked the City for the Facebook post regarding the re-opening of Green Road upon the completion of the Green/Bryden storm sewer improvements.
