I am requesting to enter a Purchase Order for the Senior's Niagara on the Lake trip scheduled for August 24-26, 2026. The amount exceeds the mayor's spending authority. The trip is included in the 2026 approved budget. We will not be offering any other overnight trips this year.

16 registered single rooms x \$1,325 = \$21,200

26 registered double rooms: x \$1,075 = \$27,950

2 registered w/o play tickets = \$2,000

Total for rooms, tickets, tours, etc = \$51,150

Estimated escort meals, trip bus snacks = \$1,540

Total cost for the trip: \$52,690

Total revenue collected = \$52,690

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-75

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PAYMENT FOR THE COMMUNITY SERVICES 2026 SENIOR ADULT TRIP TO NIAGARA-ON-THE-LAKE IN A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED THE ACTUAL COSTS FOR TRANSPORTATION, LODGING, MEALS, SNACKS AND MISCELLANEOUS EXPENSES; AND DECLARING THIS TO BE AN URGENT MEASURE

WHEREAS, the Community Services Director has planned and recommended a Senior Trip to Niagara-on-the-Lake in an amount not to exceed the actual cost for transportation, lodging, meals, snacks, and miscellaneous expenses; and

WHEREAS, these costs are reimbursed through fees charged to persons participating in said trip.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Beachwood, County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: Based upon the recommendation of the Community Services Director, the Mayor and Finance Director are hereby authorized and directed to arrange for payment for costs related to the 2026 Senior Trip to Niagara-on-the-Lake in an amount not to exceed the actual cost for transportation, lodging, meals, snacks, and miscellaneous expenses up to Fifty Two Thousand Six Hundred Ninety Dollars and No/Cents (\$52,690.00).

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions and deliberations of Council and its committees relating to the passage of this legislation that resulted in formal action were in meetings open to the public where required by Chapter 105 of the Codified Ordinances of the City.

Section 3: This Resolution is declared to be an urgent measure necessary for the public peace, health, safety, or the efficient operation of the City; and for the further reason in order to accommodate payments to the providers for lodging, meals, snacks, and miscellaneous expenses for the aforementioned trip in a timely fashion; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
