**3. Discussion of installation of sidewalks and prioritization.**

W. Griswold presented the packet put together with page numbers associated with each of the priorities and the language taken from the Master Plan.

T. Turick pointed out that the sidewalks were prioritized in the Master Plan. J. Ciuni, City Engineer, had organized his by cost and by breaking them down further over a course of years it could end up costing the City much more.

A discussion was held about how to prioritize the sidewalk installation and resident input.

A suggestion by O. Jacobs was that we should group them whether it be by commercial v. residential or by those who have no sidewalks at all v. those who have sidewalks on one side of the street.

T. Turick suggested getting a map of the sidewalks showing which side of the street already had them, if any, from the City Engineer, J. Ciuni and scheduling a committee meeting with council.

L. Coven left the meeting at approximately 6:39pm.

**4. Discussion of freeway signage and changeable copy signage for City Hall.**

W. Griswold stated that Matt Hils of OHM was contacted in regard to signage and changeable copy signage for City Hall. The cost of this is included in the Town Center package.

**5. Discussion of pedestrian bridge over Cedar Road.**

W. Griswold said that City Engineer, J. Ciuni had not gotten back to him in regard to the pedestrian bridge yet. He also spoke about a prefabricated bridge being installed overnight since Cedar Road is entirely too busy to shut down for an extended period of time. A possible location of the bridge would be northeast of Saks. A price from the manufacturer of the bridge was sought out by W. Griswold and he hoped to have more information for the next Master Plan meeting.


