1. Mayor's Report.

2. Discussion regarding reconstruction of Brandon Road and Halburton Road.

Mr. Pekarek stated that there was an item to advertise for bidders for the reconstruction of Brandon Road and Halburton Road on the agenda.

Mr. Pekarek stated that Brandon Road is in the worst condition of the two streets.

Mr. Linick stated that he wanted to have a Committee meeting to address any questions before the project is approved for bidding.

Ms. Taylor asked Mr. Pekarek to comment on the City's season for road repair and construction.

Mr. Pekarek stated that the City's season goes from May to October.

While discussing construction for this year, Mr. Berns suggested that Council should be presented at the earliest possible time in the future which streets need to be repaired.

3. Discussion regarding Richmond Road Northbound Lanes Replacement Project.

Mr. Linick stated that this issue came before the Public Works Committee Meeting several weeks ago and that he had several questions at the time.

Mr. Linick stated that he has had an opportunity to speak with the administration and other members of Council regarding this issue.

Most other members of Council would like to move forward with this project. Mr. Linick stated that this item would be going forward on the City Council agenda.

Mr. Linick stated that he would have liked to see other design concepts on this issue.

Mr. Isaacson stated that Council may need to discuss their vision for Richmond Road and then ask Mr. Pekarek and Mr. Ciuni to come up with a plan for Richmond Road.

Mr. Pasch stated that he would like to see bike lanes on Richmond Road.

Mr. Isaacson asked if Mr. Ciuni was confident in the company chosen to do the work on Richmond Road.

Mr. Ciuni stated he was comfortable with Perk Company.

Mr. Linick stated that he would still like to look into some beautification of Richmond Road.

Mr. Berns agreed and stated that it was his desire for the administration to come up with some beautification options and present them to Council soon in the future.

Mr. Berns suggested that some beautification may include new light polls, or planters.

Mayor Horwitz echoed Mr. Berns and expressed his desire for beautification along Richmond Road.

After the discussion, Mr. Linick asked if there were any further questions for this item.

There were none.

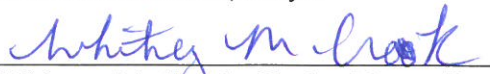
