None.

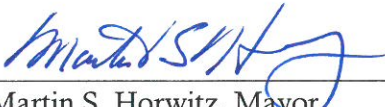
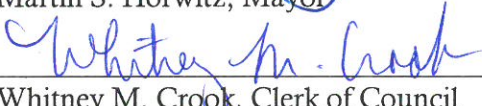

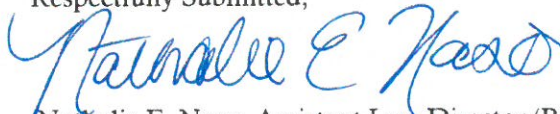

Re: City of Beachwood, Ohio Criminal Code Updates

Mr. President and Members of Council:

Attached is an exhaustive list of revisions to the Criminal Code (See Exhibit "A"). The most important revision is the amendment of the "default" penalty for offenses in the Traffic and General Codes from a misdemeanor of the first degree to a minor misdemeanor. As a result of this revision, many of the code sections will be amended. For sections in the Code that do not specify a penalty, the fall-back penalty will be a minor misdemeanor. Instead of offenders facing up to \$1,000.00 fine and six-months in jail, offenders will be looking at \$150.00 fine and no possibility jail for the minor misdemeanor. Despite the possibility of a \$1,000.00 fine on misdemeanors of the first degree, the Court does not fine people that amount (or sentence people to jail) unless there is an extenuating circumstance. I have also included a list of Code Revisions by Offense Level (See Exhibit "B"). This document contains the same information as Exhibit "A"—just synthesized differently.
